

## How to Use Your Scraps

If you are making quilts, you are also producing scraps! You can use those scraps to make more quilts that are essentially free! Join us Thursday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> to talk about how to cut our scraps into useable sizes and how to store them so they actually get used. Bring your sewing machine and sewing supplies (and of course, your scraps!), and we will make a quilt that is fun and easy.

If you want to do some pre-work, cut plenty of 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. Make sure to have some variation between light and dark. I have a booklet with over 30 patterns using these rectangles. Bring \$5.00 to cover the printing cost if you want one!

Diana Henderson called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Two ladies from the Rockport Quilt Guild were in attendance. Diana reminded everyone of the Bus Trip sign in sheet. The trip to the Houston International Quilt Festival on Oct 1, 2025. The deadline for entries to our quilt show has been extended to Sep 1, 2025. There were no corrections to the minutes from the July 2025 meeting. A motion was made to accept the minutes and was seconded by Carolyn Bradshaw and Marcia Neely. The motion passed.

Treasurer's report for July 2025 was read by Diana Henderson in Lynn Miori's absence. A motion was made to accept the report as read and was seconded by Sue Cozby and Anna Harrison.

Diana Henderson announced that at the last board meeting charity was added to the guild's mission statement. The addition will be included in the 2027 membership book. Diana also let the membership know that the Food Bank will not place a barrel at the quilt show this year due to lack of participation last year. Diana Henderson and Carolyn Bradshaw are now the administrators of the Facebook page. Diana spoke about forming a new committee for strategic planning. Discussion ensued. She asked for volunteers but did not get enough interest, so she tabled the discussion for now.

Nominations for next year's officers were discussed. There should be two people from the board and 3 people from membership. Joy Reed volunteered to be on the committee as chairman. Pat Johnson, Margaret Charnetski, Susie Jones and Peggy Loar were also appointed to the committee.

Diana also reminded members that the Budget
Committee needs to meet. The new budget will be
presented at the November meeting and voted on at
the January meeting. Lynn Miori, as treasurer, will set
the meeting date. Outgoing committee chairmen need
to submit budgets to Lynn.

Donna Zbranek will lead the Outreach Committee. She greatly enjoyed working with students this year and looks forward to doing the job again. Donna also told members she wants to have a meeting in September to recap the Quilt Show.

The ladies from the Rockport Quilt Guild presented their Opportunity Quilt. Christie Lindsay reminded our members of their quilt show in January. They had tickets for sale.

Carolyn Bradshaw explained to new members what Day 1 quilts and bags are. She asked members to commit to making quilts and bags which will be due on February 28, 2026.

Show and Tell was presented.

Karen Greer asked if the guild would renew the magazine subscription at Victoria Public Library. The board will make the decision at their next meeting. Donna Zbranek and Jo Ellen Comstock spoke about the upcoming quilt show. They talked about voting categories and ribbons. They explained how sponsor ribbons will work. There are 21 awards and a limit of 3 awards per quilt. They are very proud that the majority of expenses for the show will be paid by sponsorship money. Carolyn Bradshaw and Jo Ellen Comstock will be on the show Crossroads Today on Monday. Hugs from Texas founder Connie Kortz will have a booth at the show, and a booth at the Houston show as well. An article will be included in the Victoria Advocate tomorrow.

Sue Cozby spoke about the Scrap Dive and how it will operate this year.

Yvonne Bonorden invited members to her house on the Friday evening of the quilt show for a meet and greet at her house. She asked members to bring items made from Billy Reue's fabric to show him at the party. We have a few sick members. Kay Tindall fell and is not doing well. Nancy Penry is in the hospital. Door Prizes were awarded to Joyce Brown, Marcia Neely, Margaret Charnetski, Pat Powell and Pat Johnson.
