
President's Message

"Dear" Friends


Pieced & quilted by Susanne Bonorden Pattern "Doe" by: Madi Hastings



My inspiration for the quilt came from the deer that visit behind my house. The mother deer sometimes hide her fawns in my flower beds and I often get to watch them from a distance romp and play.

There are 232 pieces that were machine appliqued onto the background with transparent thread. I used my longarm quilting machine to do the free motion quilting.

This wall hanging won a Blue Ribbon at the Quilt Guild of Greater Victoria 2024 quilt show and Honorable Mention at the Calhoun County Quilt Guild 2025 Quilt Show. How thrilled I was to receive both ribbons!!

<u>byAnnie Organizer Bag</u>

Jo Ellen Comstock, To Sews Quilts

Pattern byAnnie – either the "In Control" or the "Catch All Caddy;" construction is the same for either bag. "In Control" is smaller than the "Catch All Caddy."



In Control Finished Size:

- 6½" Tall
- 10½" Long
- 6" Deep



Catch All Caddy Finished Size:

- 7" Tall
- 13½" Long
- 6½" Deep

Supplies:

- Pattern: Either Pattern of choice.
- Fabrics: Avoid directional fabrics until you understand the process & additional yardage may be required.
 - Main Fabric 1 yd
 - Lining Fabric 1 yd
 - o Coordination Fabric 1 yd
- Hardware:
 - Hardware (4) 1" rings (either Rectangle or D rings)
 - Optional: Snaps for Handle Snap Loop
- Zipper: 8" or longer
- Thread: to match fabrics
- General Sewing Items: Sewing machine, zipper foot, general sewing tools

Interfacings & Stabilizers:

- Foam Interfacing 18" x 58" wide -Bosal or byAnnie Soft & Stable (S&S) Stabilizer
- Fusible Interfacing ¼ yard
- Polypro Strapping 1 yard Note:
 Both Patterns call for strapping to stabilize the Handle Tabs to the body of the caddy but I use byAnnie S&S instead as there will be leftovers in this project.
- Base Stabilizer 5¾" x 12" (Foam core, plexiglass, or heavy cardboard)
