Diana Henderson (President) called the meeting to order at 9:34am.

Connie Kortz with My Fabric Friends asked guild members to help with quilts for the hill country flood victims & families. She is calling it Hugs for the Hill Country. She is asking for quilters, piecers, binding & monetary donations. She also has a pattern for a poppy quilt block pattern which will be made into a quilt to donate. She thanked those who have already participated.

Cuero Quilt Guild (Heirloom Stitchers) are selling raffle tickets for their quilt called "Call Sign Victor." They told us that they are a service guild that gives quilts and pillowcases to fire victims.

Donna Zbranek spoke on the 4-H collage wall hangings and showed some of the finished works. She also said so far, they have \$6000 in sponsorships for the quilt show and 26 quilt entries.
